



Lead Creative Schools - Call out for Creative Practitioners at Ysgol Parc y Bont Primary School, *Llanddaniel Fab, Ynys Mon.*

Project Focus

By designing and exploring ideas for an **outdoor creative learning space**, can we improve the numeracy and oracy skills among year 5 and 6 pupils?

Aim of the project:

There are 25 enthusiastic pupils in year 5 & 6, who are very much looking forward to their creative project. The school wants to maintain focus on **numeracy and oracy**, whilst also seeking to **build confidence**. They are keen to explore ideas around geography, science, environmental studies and ICT, in a fun, creative way.

Idea:

There is currently an area of playground/woodland space at the school which is overgrown and unused. The pupils would like to transform it into a fun space for creative play, bringing in ideas around 'nature.' We are looking for a practitioner to help design the space and help the pupils think creatively, focusing on **numeracy**. We also want a second practitioner to develop the pupils **oracy** skills in particular by devising stories/games/performances as a response to the creative space.

What we are looking for:

We are looking for **2 practitioners**. We are particularly looking for at least one practitioner with skills/interest in **forestry, carpentry, environment, nature, outdoor learning, wildlife** as well as one artist who can help develop confidence and oracy through **drama/storytelling/writing/performance**, as a response to the creative outdoor learning space.

Being able to communicate in **Welsh is desirable**. Welsh learners are encouraged to apply. Practitioner partnerships are also welcome to apply.

The Work:

It is envisaged that both practitioners will work with the pupils weekly, for at least 7 full day sessions at £250/day (January to March) with budget set aside for materials. There will also be time set aside for planning and evaluation work.
